## **NAMING TEST IN ENGLISH**

This test assesses language capability; the subject has to name 15 objects. These 15 objects are divided into 3 groups (low, medium and high), depending on how frequently they occur in the Hindi language and how familiar they are to the target population. Inability to name these familiar objects is a sign of language impairment, specifically impairment of expressive language/speech. We used objects rather than the conventional line diagrams.

## Instructions:

Say: "Now I am going to show you some objects. I want you to name these objects."

The subject is not to touch any of the objects.

All subjects are asked to name the objects in the same order:

- (1) 5 high frequency objects (flower, lock, bottle, elephant, rolling pin)
- (2) 5 medium frequency objects (syringe, comb, scissors, spectacles, basket)
- (3) 5 low frequency objects (flute, aeroplane, funnel, telephone, necklace)

## **SCORES**

1 = Correct response

O = Wrong answer.

Total score = Score High Frequency + Score Medium Frequency + Score Low Frequency
